Day #2 - Breakfast is included at the hotel and after we will continue our journey to the Benjamin Harrison Presidential Site. You will see three floors, ten rooms and a nationally significant collection of over 10,000 artifacts on exhibit. An extraordinary 75-80% are original to the Harrison family. Lunch will be on your own as we continue heading West and check in to the Hampton Inn in Louisville. This evening we have dinner included at the Claudia Sanders Dinner House, where you will indulge in the finest country-style dining and cooking. (B, D)

Day #3 — We will begin our morning by heading to the Twin Spires at Churchill Downs for a Backstretch Breakfast Tour of the world's most famous racetrack. The morning will consist of breakfast, a walking tour of Churchill Downs, a stable tour, and admission to the museum. We have included lunch at the Derby Café and time watching horses race on the track. This afternoon, we tour the Frazier History Museum, where the world meets Kentucky. Explore cultures past and present thru an extensive collection of historical items displaying what makes Kentucky cool. This evening we have a unique dining experience at the Famous Brown Hotel. While every meal at The Brown Hotel is memorable, we'd be remiss if we didn't suggest at least one "Hot Brown." We end the night with the Jack O'Lantern Spectacular. Presented each October along a winding path through the majestic woods of Iroquois Park, you are treated to an organic art gallery of more than 5,000 artistically carved pumpkins in themed settings. Day #4 – After breakfast, we depart for a tour of My Old Kentucky Home. Tour of the halls and rooms of one of America's most famous and celebrated landmarks. Your experience also includes the Culinary Biscuit Tour. Your guide, dressed in antebellum clothing, will demonstrate the making of the south's iconic beaten biscuits in their beautiful carriage house! Lunch will be included at Stephen Fosters Restaurant. After lunch we head over to the Heaven Hill Bourbon Experience. Next, we head back downtown and tour the Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory. "You don't have to be a big baseball fan to love Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory." The factory tour is fascinating. The interactive exhibits are fun. Baseball is such a big part of American history and culture that even folks who don't think they're fans find a connection here. Dinner the rest of the evening is yours to enjoy at Fourth Street Live in Downtown Louisville. (B, L)
