CANCELLATION POLICY:

As a reminder, our cancellation policy is as follows: once you have signed up, you are responsible for that seat/ticket. In the event you will not be able to attend and the waiting list has been exhausted, you will remain responsible for your fee. In the event of an emergency, your refund will be determined on a case-by-case basis.

RESERVATION POLICY:

Our phone system allows us to have a "Road Runner Friendly" sign up system. You are able to sign up by calling a direct phone line, which is **312-690-7603** on the designated dates between 8 AM and 10 AM.

When you call, you will receive our answering machine. Please leave your message with your NAME, PHONE NUMBER, and HOW MANY seats you want to reserve (you and a spouse or you and a guest). Our answering machine records the dates and time of your call. Please don't call the office before 8 AM or your call will not be counted. ONLY phone sign ups will be accepted during those two hours.

After 10:00 AM, you may stop in or call any FSB branch to reserve your seat. If all seats are sold, you will be placed on the waiting list. One of our Road Runner representatives will call you back to confirm your reservation, and fill you in on the necessary details within two days. We feel this gives every Flanagan State Bank customer a fair opportunity.
